Outpatient Abdominal Ultrasound Services for Your Patients



Portland Veterinary Emergency & Specialty Care is pleased to partner with you by offering **outpatient abdominal ultrasounds** performed by our Internal Medicine team. This service is designed to support your diagnostics while you maintain primary case management.

What Is an Outpatient Ultrasound?

An outpatient ultrasound is a **focused imaging appointment only**:

- Abdominal ultrasound performed by a PVESC Internal Medicine specialist
- No full internal medicine consultation or comprehensive physical examination will be performed
- · Imaging report is sent directly back to you
- Your hospital retains the **primary doctor-client-patient relationship**
- Ideal for **stable patients** when you need advanced imaging to guide your ongoing work-up or treatment plan.
- Outpatient ultrasound cost: \$495

When to Choose Outpatient Ultrasound (vs. an Internal Medicine Consultation)

Outpatient Ultrasound is typically appropriate when:

- You have a working diagnosis and need confirmation or staging
- You've already performed an initial work-up (lab work, radiographs, etc.)
- The patient is stable and you plan to continue managing the case
- You'd like rapid access to imaging and a written specialist report

If you're unsure which option is best, our team is happy to help you decide. Internal Medicine Consultation is typically appropriate when:

- The case is complex, chronic, or multi-systemic
- Diagnosis is unclear despite initial work-up
- You'd like a full exam and consult with the owner by an internist
- Long-term case management, additional diagnostics, or advanced therapies are anticipated
- A need for ultrasound guided sampling (I.e. fine needle aspirates) or sedation is anticipated

How the Outpatient Ultrasound Process Works



You submit a referral

- Complete the Outpatient Ultrasound Referral Form •
- Include recent history, diagnostics, medications, and your specific questions.



You or your client schedules the appointment

- You or your client call us at 207-878-3121 after referral form is submitted to schedule the ultrasound at PVESC.
- Any patient preparation instructions are reviewed at that time. We ask that patients do not eat the day of the ultrasound. They can have water.
